TUITION AND REGISTRATION

Our 2015-2016 school year runs from September through May. We kick off the year with Parent Orientation on September 2nd and an open house on September 3rd. Classes begin right after Labor Day, with our 3-year-olds starting on September 8th and the 4-year-olds on September 9th.

At the time of registration, we collect a \$90.00 non-refundable registration fee and one month's tuition payment, which is applied toward May of the year for which the child is being enrolled. Families enrolling more than one child for the year will pay the full registration fee and tuition for the first child. Each additional child's registration fee will be at a reduced rate of \$80.00, and tuition will be reduced by \$20.00 per month.

ENROLLMENT

In compliance with state regulations, all SPUMCNS students must meet the following requirements:

1. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age prior to September 1st. A copy of the birth certificate must be submitted to register.
2. All immunizations must be current, and be documented on a form signed by the physician and kept at the school.
3. All children must be toilet trained.
4. Our school is nut- and peanut- free and serves a daily snack. However, parents of children with food allergies/dietary restrictions must provide their child's snack.
